#### The School Day:

We will continue with Active Maths as part of our maths lessons each week.

#### <u>Reading:</u>

We will be continuing with Guided Reading this term, the children will read in school on a Wednesday, Thursday and Friday then they will bring their book home to share with you. They will also have a sharing book each week.


#### Wow Baa

#### Spellings and Times Tables

This term the children will bring home a set of spellings to practice each week (on a Monday). They will also have access to Spelling Shed if they would like to practice online (please find the login in your child's reading diary). The children will have a more formal assessment using spelling books the following Monday, starting on 15<sup>th</sup> January. The class will be tested on their times tables each Friday — They will need to get full marks for 3 weeks running before moving onto the next set. We will start with 10's then 5's then 2's.
