English & Maths



Our English work this half term will be a report of the murder of King Duncan from Shakespeare's Macbeth. The children will also be writing the content for a website on Tudor life.

In maths, we will be looking at column multiplication and short division, multiplying fractions and finding fractions of an amount/ quantity.


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This half term we will be looking at space. An in depth study of all the planets is not part of this unit but rather a real focus on the Earth, sun and moon, how they move and how this movement causes day/night and seasons.

RE

Our overarching question in RE is 'How are religious and spiritual thoughts and beliefs expressed in arts and architecture and in charity and generosity.



The class will be following on from their science last half term and bringing their understanding of mechanisms in to their D&T. They will be using CAMS to create moving parts to space themed toys.

PSHE

Our theme for PSHE this half term is 'keeping safe' in which they will learn to demonstrate strategies to deal with both face-to-face and online bullying as well as the strategies and skills for supporting others who are bullied. Another aspect they will be looking at is vaping. Describe some of the health risks caused by vaping with the aim that they understand there are potential health risks of vaping that are not yet fully known. This is a precursor to their DAaRT work in year 6.

Computing

In computing, the class will identify some of the types of data that the Mars Rover could collect (for example, photos); explain how the Mars Rover transmits the data back to Earth and the challenges involved in this. They will learn to read any number in binary, up to eight bits.
