

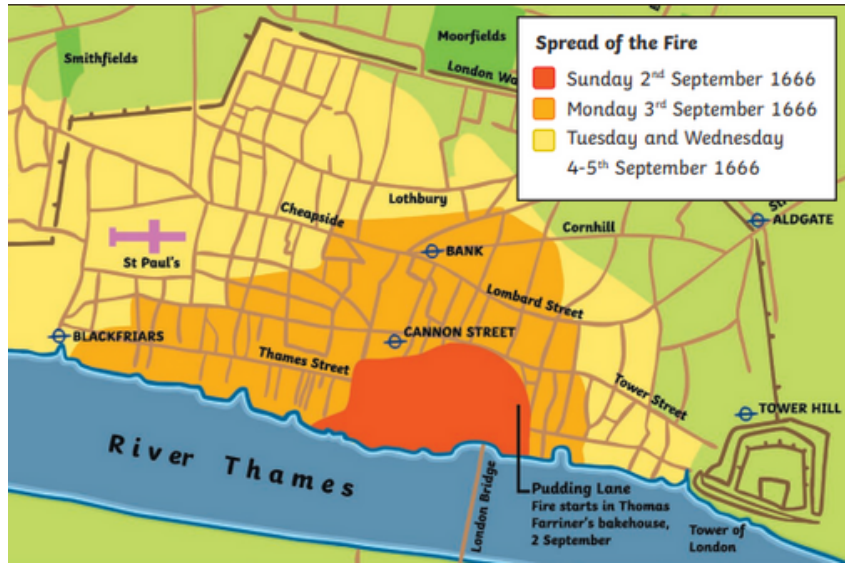

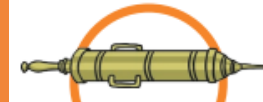

## TIMELINE OF EVENTS

**Sunday**

2nd September 1666



The fire starts at a bakery on Pudding Lane. Samuel Pepys starts writing in his diary.

**Monday**

3rd September 1666



The fire gets very close to the Tower of London.

**Tuesday**

4th September 1666



St Paul's Cathedral is destroyed by the fire.

**Wednesday**

5th September 1666



The wind dies down and the fire spreads more slowly.

**Thursday**

6th September 1666



The fire is finally put out. Thousands of people are left homeless.
