The United Kingdom

The United Kingdom is split into different countries, England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. Each of these are split into areas called Counties. Each County contains Cities, Towns and Villages.

KEY VOCABULARY

city - a large area where many people live together.

compass directions - north, north east, east, south east, south, south west, west, north west.

continent - a large solid area of land

country - land that is controlled by a single government.

county - the name for a piece of land.

Great Britain - the name for three nations on the main isle: England, Scotland and Wales.

human feature - things that have been built by people like houses, roads, shops etc.

industry - a group of businesses that make or sell similar products or perform similar services.

mountain - a landform that rises high above the surrounding terrain in a limited area.

physical feature - things that you can see all around you, made by nature like lakes, hills, rivers beaches etc.

region - an area of land that has common features.

river - a flowing stream of water that leads to the sea, a lake or another river.

settlement - places where people live and sometimes work.

The British Isles - a geographic area in Europe that includes the large island of Great Britain.

The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland - an island country of western Europe.

town - a place where people live which is smaller than a city.

village - a place where people live which is smaller than a town.



Local Area - Calverton

Calverton is a village in Nottinghamshire. It is 7 miles north-east of Nottingham and 10 miles south-east of Mansfield. In the 2021 census it found 7,579 inhabitants in 3,326 households.



Changes in Calverton:

- Used to be a mining village.
- New safety measures (zebra crossing on main street).
- New houses being built.
- New shops added in different areas.

For the London 2012 Olympics a transformation of the area around Stratford, east London, took 7 years to get ready for the games. This was a major transformation of the area and it continued to change after the games had ended.
