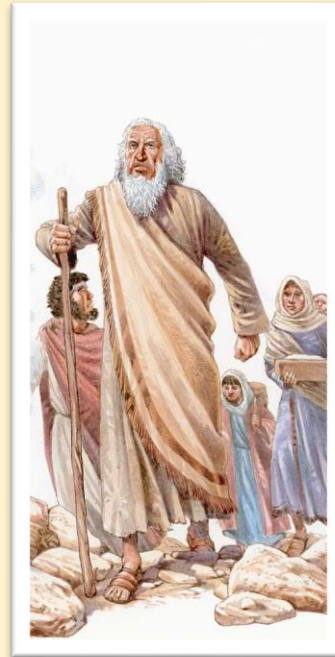


What makes some people inspiring to others?

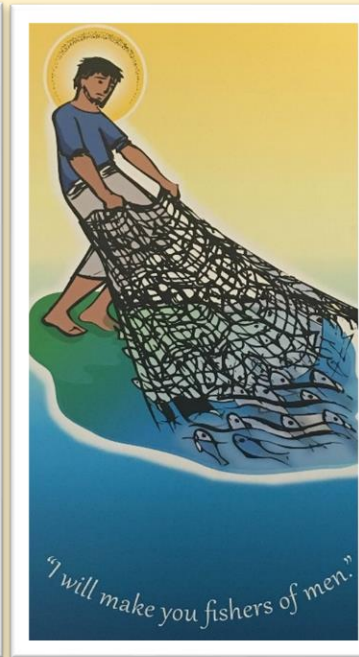

Saint Peter

Peter was one of the disciples of Jesus. When Jesus died, Peter was the first Christian leader, travelling far a wide to spread the good news of Jesus. There are many stories about Peter in the New Testament of the Bible that help us understand why he was an inspirational leader.

Vocabulary

Religion: the belief in and worship of a god.

Christian: someone who believes Jesus is the son of God and follows his teachings.

Jewish: to follow the teachings of Judaism, a religion.

Bible: the special book for Christians.

Torah: the special book for Jews.

Wise sayings: a short well known sentence that shows what is a right action.

Co-operation: working together for the same end result.
