

Home School Agreement

Dear Parents/ Carers,

As new members of our St. Wilfrid's School community, the Home School Agreement outlines the aims and expectations of school, parents and pupils. By following the guidance below, we hope that your child's experience will be a wholly positive one, and that s/he will reach their academic, social and spiritual potential.

The school will...

Value and respect each child as an individual.
Encourage high expectations and pride in achievement.
Recognise and praise progress and achievement.
Provide opportunities for pupils to develop their potential in all areas.
Inform parents of the progress and welfare of their child.
Provide and monitor homework which is appropriate to the child's needs.
Provide a safe and orderly environment in which to work.
Listen to parents' views and concerns and make an initial response within 24 hours on week days, during term time.

Parents are asked to...

Support the school in its aims and values, and have an understanding of our school policies and communication avenues.
Ensure their child's regular and punctual attendance.
Notify the school early on the first day of the reason for their child's absence.
Support the school's code of conduct for behaviour.
Support the school's code of conduct for parents / carers
Support their child with any homework set.
Tell the school about any circumstances that may significantly affect their child.
Attend parents' evenings and discussions about their child's progress.
Raise any concerns that might arise from time to time with the school directly and in accordance with the concerns and complaints policy.
Ensure their child wears the correct school uniform.
Desist from posting defamatory, offensive or derogatory comments regarding the school or any of the pupils, parents, staff and governors at the school on Facebook, Wats App or other social media platforms (including closed or private accounts).
Adhere to the school's parents' / carers' code of conduct (available on the school website, or from the school office).
Respect both teaching and personal staff time when communicating via email and the school office.

Pupils will:

Respect each member of the school community.
Abide by the school's code of conduct / behaviour code
Attend school regularly and punctually and bring the correct equipment.
Look after the school and its surroundings.
Try their best and work hard.
Wear the correct school uniform.
