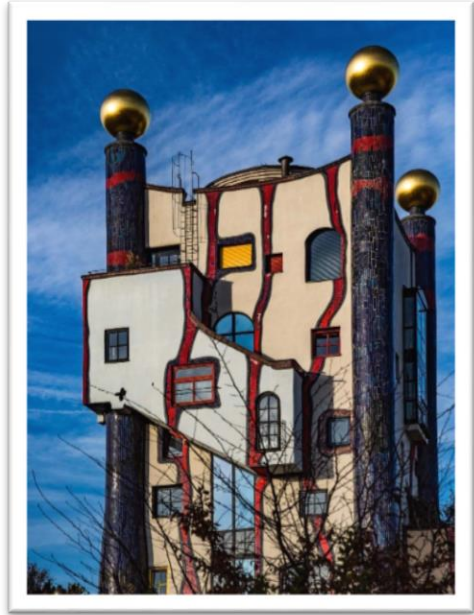




Hundertwasser

What is an Architect?

An architect is a person who designs buildings and prepares plans to give to a builder. What they design is called architecture. They make drawings with pens, pencils, and computers. Sometimes they make small toy-sized buildings called models to show what the building will look like when it is done.



Vocabulary:

Architect: someone who designs buildings.

Architecture: the design of a building.

Design: a look or shape given to an object.

Form: three-dimensional shape.

Model: a smaller scaled representation of a building.

Key Knowledge

- Architects design buildings and other structures which relate to our bodies and which enhance our environment.
- Architects take inspiration from the environment their building will be in, and from the people who will use it, to design exciting structures.
- We can use drawing as a way to help us process and understand other people's work.
- We can use our imaginations to make architectural models to explore how we might design buildings for a particular need.
- We can use "Design Through Making" (some call it Make First) as a way to link our imagination, hands and materials.
