PLATINUM JUBILEE- THURSDAY 26TH MAY


Children may come to school dressed in red, white and blue on Thursday. Children will be having a special 'street' party, with lunch on the field (deadline to order has now passed).

RECEPTION PLACES - SEPTEMBER 2022
