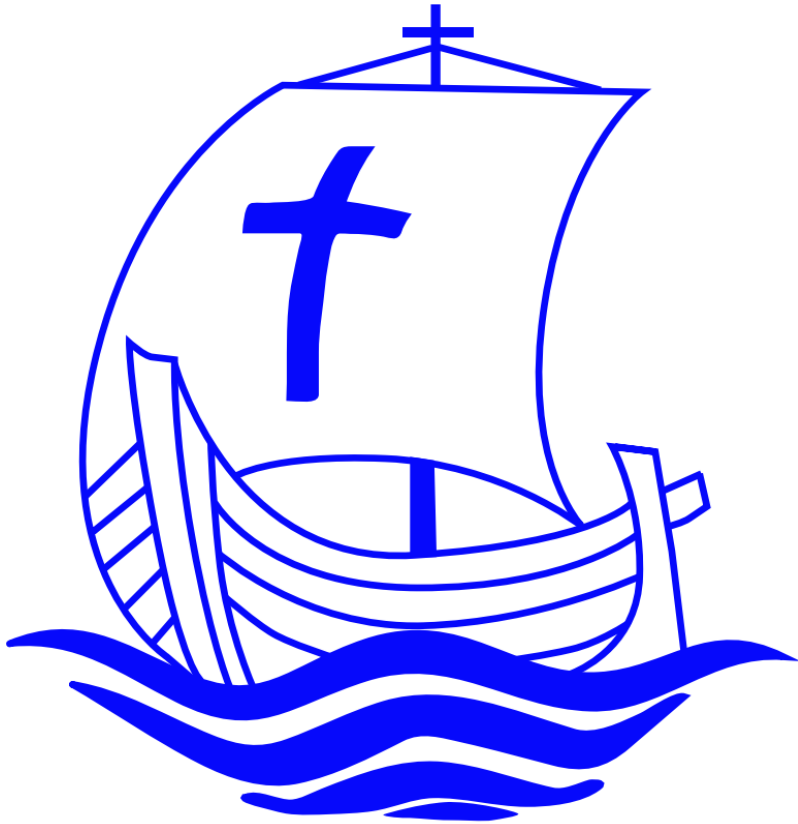








YEAR 6 LONG TERM PLAN 23-24
