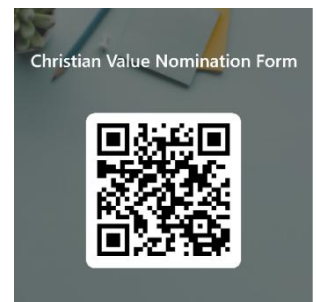


## A Note from Miss Cousin

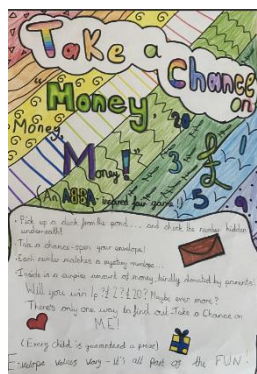
victory. Amazing responsibility Theo!

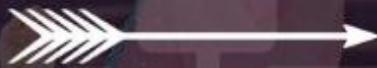
