Slots will open during the week commencing **2nd March**, and all teachers' appointments will be available by **Friday 6th March**. Booking will remain open until **Friday 20th March**.

If you feel it would be helpful, please complete the parent feedback form prior to your appointment. This allows you to share any information that may be useful for the teacher to know ahead of the meeting, such as:

- Home or family circumstances that may impact your child's learning or wellbeing.
- Any concerns regarding homework or specific subjects such as reading, writing or maths.
- Questions you would like addressed during the meeting.

Your child is regularly assessed in reading, writing, maths and the wider curriculum to set targets and predict end-of-year outcomes. Year 2+ reading book bands will also be shared. We value the partnership between home and school and strongly encourage all parents and carers to attend. Working together gives us the very best opportunity to support your child in achieving their full potential.
