- **Year 4:** Mr Clapham with Mrs Henson covering PPA
- **Year 5:** Mrs Martin and Mrs Henson and Mrs Haley covering PPA and Management time - they will share their timetable in due course.
- **Year 6:** Mrs Wood.

Mrs Streets will continue to support children across the school as our Pastoral Teaching Assistant.

You may also notice that not all Teaching Assistants are listed above. This is because we are adapting our support model to move away from traditional class-based roles, similar to last year but with a greater focus on 1:1 support where needed. Our Teaching Assistants will either work with specific children - which will be shared with the relevant families - or work flexibly across the school to ensure every child receives the tailored support they need to flourish, including through targeted interventions.

Class teachers will share further details in their start-of-year newsletters, including PPA arrangements. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Mr Streets and the site staff, our lunchtime team, SClub, Mrs Porter and Mrs Fisher for their continued dedication and hard work behind the scenes.
